FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: Do you grow all the flowers?

A: Yes! All flowers are grown by us. This way we can ensure the highest quality of the flowers and that they're grown in a way that is conscious of the environment and that is kind to soil, insect, animal and bird life here on the farm. As a result, our flowers carry a minimal carbon footprint. They are also not treated with any chemicals and are not, at any point, swathed in wraps of cellophane. We are proud of the fact that we have pretty much entirely phased out single use plastics on the farm.

Q: What will be in season at the time of my wedding?

A: Here is a rough guide of what we expect to have throughout our growing season:

April:

Tulip, Anemone, Hellebore, Narcissus, Exochorda, Icelandic Poppy, apple-blossom, Ranunculus, Stock

May:

Anemone, Aquilegia, Astrantia, Centaurea, Geum, Hesperis, Icelandic Poppy, Ranunculus, Sweet-Pea, Viburnum, Orlaya

June:

Achillea, Allium, Calendula, Delphinium, Digitalis, Eryngium, Geum, Gladioli, Gypsophila, Nepeta, Nigella, Pelargonium, Peony, Rose, Scabious, Sweet-Pea

July:

Achillea, Antirrhinum, Cosmos, Daucus, Echinacea, Eryngium, Hydrangea, Knautia, Limonium, Nigella, Pelargonium, Phlox, Rose, Sanguisorba, Scabious, Sweet-Pea

August:

Antirrhinum, Cosmos, Dahlias, Didiscus, Echinacea, Eryngium, Helianthus, Helichrysum, Hydrangea, Limonium, lots of types of grasses, Nicotiana, Rose, Phlox, Scabious



September:

Acidanthera, Japanese Anemone, Cosmos, Dahlia, Didiscus, Gaura, Helianthus, Helichrysum, lots of grasses, Nicotiana, Pelargonium, Phlox, Rose, Scabious, Zinnia

October - March:

Outside of our growing season, we have a range of seasonal foliage and a huge selection of flowers that we have dried throughout the summer months. Please get in touch if you would like to explore this further.

Q: How many buckets will I need?

A: As a general rule of thumb, you'll need around 10-15 stems for posies; 25-50 stems for bouquets; 1-5 stems for bud vases and 30-50 stems for vases. The exact stem count will depend on your particular style. Our buckets contain a minimum of 50 stems, many of which will have a number of side shoots which can be broken down into more usable stems.

Q: Can we hire vessels off you?

A: All prices for ready to wear elements needing vases or urns include the cost of any vessel used, which is yours to keep. Of course, we will refund you for any returned vessels. If you wish to provide your own glassware, we will amend our price to reflect this.

Q: Can we choose our flowers?

A: Absolutely! It's such a fun thing to do and gives you a lot of input into the final design of your flowers. As flower availability changes on a weekly basis, please ensure you would be able to visit us 7-10 days before the date of your wedding. We are not open on weekends or evenings. We do have a minimum spend of £500 for this.

Q: What should I do if I want to make a booking?

A: Please submit an enquiry via the form on our website or email Milly at info@flowerandfarmer.com, letting us know what you would like. We will get back to you as soon as possible with a quote. We ask for a 50% deposit to secure your booking and have a minimum spend of £350.
